Wedding Rate Card 2015/16

- Ceremony charge - £300 - £800

In the first instance, please contact with Bodmin Registrars on 0300 1234 181 or to enquire about availability for your chosen dates. Charge for sole use of the ceremony room for the duration of the ceremony along with associated assistance from appropriate hotel staff as required. Please note there may be additional chair hire costs if additional seating is required. Actual charge will depend on the date and time of the ceremony with Winter / mid-week / Before 12pm / After 3pm being at lower end of the range.

If you are holding your reception here then all rooms must be booked for the night of the wedding. There is no such requirement for Ceremony bookings only. Over bank holidays or during August a two night minimum booking may be required.

- Reception Venue Charge - £800 - £2500

Charge for sole use of the hotel for the wedding day until 11am the next morning. This covers all the extra work, planning and staffing which go into making your day the special occasion you are looking for. The charge will again depend on the date of your wedding with June – September and bank holidays being the most expensive.

- Wedding Breakfast - £40 - £60 per head for 3 course meal

Our chefs will develop a menu to your requirements

- Evening Buffet - £20 - £40 per head

- Bar prices – See below (or prevailing bar prices at the time, whichever is higher)

House wine - £15.50 per bottle / Prosecco - £20 / Camel Valley 'Brut' - £38 / Taittinger - £53

Corkage charge for supplying own wine - £15 per bottle

- Lighting Rig / Sound system hire - £400

We have our own lighting rig available to hire as well as plug ins for DJs to our sound system. Please note, we do not provide DJs.

Capacities

We can cater for 65 reception guests if you are having a sit down meal and approximately 200 for a buffet and for the evening entertainment. We have also had marquees in the car park for previous receptions to increase capacity further.
